

In this regard it is respectfully submitted that

SUBJECT MATTER OF INFORMATION:

- (i) Affairs of the Jaspur Cooperative Agriculture Service Society Limited and Governing the services of its employees Societies in Punjab in Ajnara Taluk of Amritsar District.
- (ii) Period for which the information relates: Otherwise stated different dates, the information may be furnished from 01 January 2014 till 31 March 2018.

BRIEF HISTORY

1. RTI Application dated 01 May 2018 was delivered by Speed Post No. RLNP730344896IN dated 01 May 2018 fee of Rs. 10.00 v/s I.R.O. No. 43E 389795 to Respondent Public Information Officer of Office RoC, Chandigarh seeking information on 08 points.
2. No information received till the date of filing this appeal, even after the stipulated time of under law has elapsed (48 days).
3. Hence, This Appeal under section 19(1) of Right to Information Act, 2005
4. ID proof of the Appellant is attached

GROUND OF APPEAL

1. No information has been received from the Respondent Public Information Officer of the Office of Registrar Cooperative Societies, Chandigarh.
2. Till now Delinquent Respondent Public Information Officer deliberately avoided giving information with *malafide* intention.
3. The Respondent Public Information Officer has failed to act as per the provisions of the law. Thus, he has derelict on his lawful responsibility.
4. The Delinquent Respondent Public Information Officer has exposed himself to the disciplinary action as per the service conduct rules applicable to them, which could lead to his dismissal from the service.
5. The Respondent Public Information Officer has tried to suppress and mislead and avoid collecting, collating and supply of the information *wilfully and deliberately* with *malafide* intention by refusing to respond to the RTI Application!!
6. Respondent Public Information Officer has not followed the instruction contained in the DoPT Government of India Ministry of Personnel, PG & Pension Department of Personnel & Training North Block, New Delhi Circular No. 10/1/2013-IR dated 06 October 2015.

ON MERIT

1. The Respondent Public Information Officer has failed to perform as per requirement of law, infringed my right to seek information under section 6(1) read with 2(f) of the RTI Act and has exposed himself for penal action under section 5(4), 6(3), 7(2), 7(8), 20(1) and 20(2) of the Right to Information Act 2005.

RELIEF SOUGHT


2. The Delinquent Respondent Public Information Officer may please be directed to personally collate and collect the complete information from wherever it lay and supply the same to the appellant expeditiously.
3. The Delinquent Respondent Public Information Officer may be summoned together with record and the information may be extracted therefrom and the legible and certified copies may be supplied to me on the spot, in term of OM No. 10/1/2013-IR dated 6th October 2015 of Government of India, Ministry of Personnel, PG and Pension Department of Personnel & Training North Block, New Delhi.
- [REDACTED] The information supplied must be certified in terms of Section 2(j) of the Right to Information Act, 2005 may ordered to be supplied.
5. The Delinquent Respondents Public Information Officer, may be directed to now supply the information on the all points **FREE OF COST** under Section 7(6) of the Right to information Act, 2005.
6. The Respondent Public Information Officer has failed to perform as per requirement of law under section 2(f), 5(4), 6(1), 7(1), 7(3) and 7(8) of the RTI Act
7. The Delinquent Respondent Public Information Officer, for performing against the spirit of the Right to information Act, 2005 and by not following the (above) law and not performing his duty, has committed a "gross-misconduct" of serious nature. May be proceeded against the departmental conduct rules as applicable to Cooperative Department, Punjab.
8. [REDACTED] The appellant may please be suitably compensated under section 19(8)(b) of the Right to information Act, 2005 for the costs and detriments suffered, as well as for the deficient service and mental agony, the same may be recovered from the salary of the Delinquent Respondent Public Information Officer.
9. That the practice in the Public Authority in relation to the exercise of its functions under this Act does not conform with the provisions or spirit of this Act, Appellate Authority may give to the authority a recommendation specifying the steps which ought in its opinion to be taken for promoting such conformity under section 25(5).
10. Any other relief may please be granted, which may be warranted.

The appellant may be called for hearing and no matter may be disposed of without the assistance of the appellant and ensuring the process of natural Justice. The Respondent & the Information Officer may not be heard in isolation, if done so, the proceedings may be video recorded and on the file and a copy of the same may be supplied to the appellant invariably. Also a reasoned order may be passed for allowing or disallowing each of the 10 relief sought.

It is certified that that no other Appeal has been filed in this case except this one, no other remedy has been availed of as yet. It is further certified that the appellant is a citizen of India and seeking information as a matter of right under the Right to Information Act, 2005.
